Tung Wah Outstanding Students Admission to Secondary 1 Scholarship	TWGHs Outstanding Students (Top five)	The top five TWGHs Outstanding Students who have also been successfully admitted into any TWGHs secondary school in 2022/23. * If the awardees are among the top five in the total average score obtained in Summative Assessment 3 in P.5 and Summative Assessment 1 in P.6, they will receive an additional scholarship of HK\$5,000.	HK\$10,000 (One student from each school)
Tung Wah Student of the Year Award (Extra-curricular activities)	The best student in terms of extra-curricular activity participation and performance.	Teachers nominate students who have the highest degree of participation in extra-curricular activities and receive the most prizes in competitions (all aspects). This pool of nominees is then further narrowed according to the criteria for selection.	HK\$1,000 (One student from each school)
Mr. Robert Chiu-yin Kwan JP Scholarship	Students who have made significant improvement in their academic performance	Students who have made the most improvement in their total average scores. They must also have a positive learning attitude. Calculation method: P.1-P.6: the total average score of the Summative Assessment 2 minus the total average score of the Summative Assessment 1.	HK\$300 (One student in P.1-P.3 and one student in P.4-P.6)

Leung King Mau Memorial Scholarship	Top three students in terms of academic results in each grade.	P.1-P.5 students are assessed based on the total average score obtained in Summative Assessment 2 and Summative Assessment 3. P.6 students are assessed based on the total average score obtained in Summative Assessment 2.	1 st : HK\$150 2 nd : HK\$100 3 rd : HK\$50
Ma Kam Chan Subject Prize	Top student in terms of Chinese, English and Mathematics results in each class.	P.1-P.5 students are assessed based on the total score obtained in Chinese, English or Mathematics in Summative Assessment 2 and Summative Assessment 3. P.6 students are assessed based on the total score obtained in Chinese, English or Mathematics in Summative Assessment 1 and Summative Assessment 2.	HK\$100 (Prizes are set for Chinese, English and Mathematics respectively in each class.)
Ma Kam Chan Outstanding Improvement Prize	Students with the most significant improvement in academic result and can demonstrate a self-motivated learning attitude.	Students with the highest rate of improvement between the total average score obtained in Summative Assessment 2 and Summative Assessment 3 and can demonstrate a positive learning attitude. Ma Kam Chan Outstanding Arts and Sports Award	Students with the most outstanding performance in the subjects of Music, Visual Arts and Physical Education.	We select students with the most outstanding performance in Music, Visual Arts and Physical Education subjects.	HK\$200 (Prizes are set for Music, Visual Arts and Physical Education subjects respectively.)
