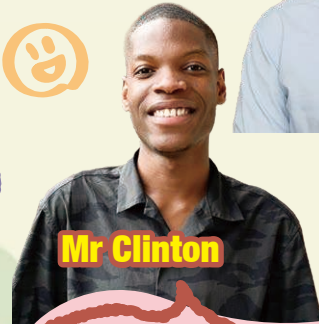

Students play a game with Miss Fadia matching animals with their habitats.

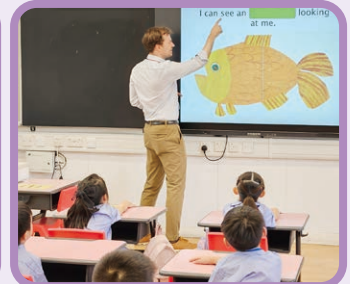

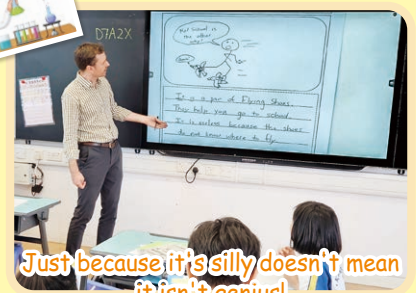

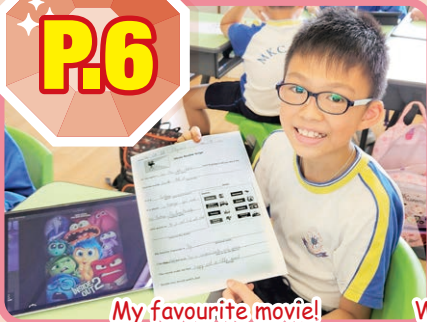
